Information Source Formats (Types)

Important: use many different formats

	They have been edited and published which makes this resource generally reliable. Eg. Books, periodicals (magazines such as Faces), newspapers, and reference materials such as encyclopedias (generaliation spesifications, maps, charts, etc
SAZE .	Eg. Video and music recordings (CD, MP3, DVD, Blay, MP3), movies, TV broadcasts, photos, clipart, posters, drawings, diagrams, graphs, etc.)
